

## INFORMAL WETLAND DELINEATION DISPUTE FORM

PLEASE COMPLETE ALL APPLICABLE SECTIONS. A fee for this review is not required. Incomplete applications will not be processed until all missing information is provided. Return completed applications to the Environmental Protection Commission (EPC) Attn: Wetlands Division, 3629 Queen Palm Drive, Tampa, FL 33619.

Under the Informal Wetland Delineation Dispute process, staff decisions are appealed to the next higher managerial level. This request must be submitted to the Environmental Protection Commission (EPC) of Hillsborough County within 6 months of the initial wetland delineation and prior to survey submittal. The timeline for conclusion of the dispute shall be 30 days, unless extenuating circumstances allow for an unforeseen delay.

The <u>entire</u> site, as included in the original application for wetland and other surface water determinations, must be assessed utilizing the methodology identified in Chapter 62-340, Florida Administrative Code. Application of the methodology may result in the delineation of a wetland or surface water area that is different (larger, smaller, or altered configuration) than that originally set by EPC staff.
