## BROWNFIELDS AND OLD LANDFILL REDEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS

In the county, 72 Brownfield sites are currently in assessment, cleanup or closure phases of redevelopment.

41 sites are managed solely by the EPC through our state delegated program.

The EPC is poised approve its 122<sup>nd</sup> old landfill redevelopment project.














**RED TIDE Concentrations**
