

- Air and Water Monitoring Comprehensive and unbiased
- Waste, Wetland, Water and Air:

<u>Permitting</u> – protective yet cooperative

<u>Compliance Assistance</u> – proactive and promoting environmental stewardship

Enforcement – fair and consistent

- Identification of air quality hot spots requiring industry cleanup
- Improving air quality for five public schools including two elementary schools



Protecting drinking water through administration of the state's Petroleum Tanks Program. Cleanup up 1,809 discharge sites since 1989.


EPC oversees the cleanup of petroleum contaminated groundwater and soil.




The Health of Our Water

Improving water quality in our major tributaries – Hillsborough River, Alafia River, Little Manatee River – through regular monitoring




Total Nitrogen Percent Attainment at Monitoring Stations




